

## W7SKY Sky Valley Amateur Radio Club 'Net'

This is the W7SKY Sky Valley Amateur Radio Club weekly net for *<day/month/year>*.

I am *<your first name>*, *<your call sign>*, and shall be the Net Control Station for this session.

The purpose of this net is to not only provide on-air training and coordination with joint activities of the Sky Valley Amateur Radio Club and the Auxiliary Communications Service, but also for the exchange of information of interest to the amateur radio community.

*<Let repeater drop momentarily>*

This is a directed net. All stations must use their call sign for recognition by net control. Please do not relay unless asked to do so. If you need to break into the net to leave or for any other reason, give your call sign only and wait to be acknowledged by the net control station.

*<Let repeater drop momentarily>*

Be advised that stations with priority or emergency traffic shall be handled prior to continuing the net. Any station with priority or emergency traffic at this time, please come now.

*<Let repeater drop, pause and listen>*

This is Net Control Station *<your call sign>*

Please stand by for Sky Valley Amateur Radio Club Member check-in. Check-in shall be alphabetical by call sign suffix. When checking in please respond with your call sign, name, location and indicate if you have any traffic. Hold your traffic until later direction from Net Control. Late members and visitors shall check in near the end of the net after announcements and traffic.

*<Let repeater drop, pause, listen and note traffic>*

Now calling:

Member suffixes Alpha through Hotel please come now.

Member suffixes India through Quebec please come now.

Member suffixes Romeo through Zulu please come now.

Now calling for visitors. Visitors respond with your call sign, name and location. Visitors please come now.

*<Let repeater drop, pause, listen and confirm visitor check-ins>*

<If repeater is down, skip the next paragraph>

Now calling for stations without sub-audible tone capability. Please check in on the output of the repeater, 444.125 MHz or 145.650 MHz. Please wait for the repeater to drop before checking in. All other stations please standby and copy for possible relays. Toneless stations, please come now.

<Let repeater drop, pause and listen>

Any relays, please come now.

<Let repeater drop, pause and listen>

This is Net Control Station <your call sign>.

Now calling for stations with listen traffic or announcements at this time, starting with: \_\_\_\_\_

<If no traffic move on. If there is traffic, call each listing station; ask for questions after. Help arrange requested contacts off frequency or for after net>

This is Sky Valley Amateur Radio Club Net Control Station now calling for LATE or MISSED check-ins.

Late or missed member suffixes Alpha through Mike, please come now.

Late or missed visitor check-in, please come now.

<Let repeater drop, pause and listen>

Relays or traffic of any kind, please come now.

<Let repeater drop, pause and listen>

Good evening and thank you all for participating in the net. The W7SKY Sky Valley Amateur Radio Club Net meets every Tuesday at 1930 hours local time on a frequency of 444.125 MHz with a 103.5 Hz sub-audible tone and is linked on the 2-meter side on 145.650 MHz simplex. Please note that if a repeater failure should occur during net time, we shall meet on the 145.650 MHz simplex frequency. Further information is available on the club website at W7SKY.ORG.

This net is now closed at <24-hour format time> hours.

Now returning the frequencies to regular amateur use.
