### **New Business**

Guest Speaker Rowland Brasch K7RWB of the Snoqualmie Valley ARC was introduced. He put forth a proposal for creating a regional emergency response network for the greater Snohomish Valley geographical area. A repeater effective for the area would need to be identified and tested. Tiger Mountain, Rattlesnake Ridge, Haystack Mountain, and Granite Falls repeaters were suggested. Bands to be used were discussed as well as a ZOOM group for idea exchange. Rowland will be directing emails to SVARC through Tom K8TOM. Rowland K7RWB will be "Traffic Copping" the project and he stressed that the project is in the "Suggestion" stage and many resources will have to be identified. There was total agreement that such a net is vital and necessary if the amateur radio community is to provide maximum communications support.

Bill KE7WTR inquired about the status of the new Fire Station in Sultan. David KB7GFL reported that he and Garth KA7BVS had toured the facility with the Fire Chief and reported that the facility is not yet open to the public. He also reported that locating our antenna must be worked out. Steve N7SRR suggested that our repeater tones be restored to the website in order to encourage more visitors.
